Australian Ballet Tour

THE Australian Ballet are to make their second international tour next year when, during six months away from Australia, they will appear in Montreal for EXPO '67, New Zealand, and South American countries. The repertoire will include Robert Helpmann's "The Display" and "Yugen", both of which were specially created for the Company. "Elektra", "Melbourne Cup", Rudolf Nureyev's "Raymonda", "The Lady and the Fool" and the second act of "Swan Lake".

Before their departure overseas in February, the Company are having seasons in Adelaide and Melbourne. For the Melbourne season Kathleen Wortham, who is returning as guest artist. She will also be dancing on the overseas tour, and in Montreal the company will be joined by Garth Welch, who at present is studying on a scholarship in New York.

Her place has been filled by Patricia Cox who is now in Australia. Karl Welan, who was repatriated to the Company and Bryan Lawrence, from England, has decided to settle in Australia. He is to marry Janet Karin, one of the Company's most promising dancers.

Obituary

BRIAN TYLER

BRIAN TYLER, company manager of "Wait Until Dark" at the Strand, was found dead in his Bayswater flat on November 8th. He had also been manager of "An Ideal Husband", the previous production at the Strand. He was 34.

HILDA SCOTT

HILDA SCOTT died at Hove on November 15, after a long illness. She was Patrick Ide's partner in management for about 30 years and before that she was private secretary and then general manager to Charles Macdonald. She was an ardent Shavian and it was she who persuaded him to present Shaw instead of musical comedies, which has been his previous interest in the theatre.

Esme Percy, writing of her in the Mander - Mitchenson Theatre Companion to Shaw, says: "It was Hilda Scott who during my long association with Charles Macdonald, by her steadfastness and unswerving devotion to Shaw, presented Shaw without the reward of any public recognition contributed so much to making the Macdonald Players one of the most important assets of the British theatre."
